
Pop-Up Instructions

What You'll Need

- Images and instructions printed on card-weight paper
- Clear tape
- Scissors (for kids) and/or Xacto® knife (for adults)
- Glue

Making the Background Card

- Trim white borders from sky and lawn pages.
- Flip pages to back side. Tape together along short ends.





Cutting Out the Pop-Ups

Gut out Capitol and presidential group, including tabs, along outside edges.

(You can either leave the gray background between everyone's head, or cut it away if you're skilled at cutting).


Fold all tabs back along dashed green lines.





Assembling the Pop-Ups


Glue Tab A at bottom of Capitol to lawn page, with edge of tab along card's centerfold.



- Push Capitol forward, face down on lawn.
 Pull Tabs B and C back toward card's centerfold.
- Glue ends of Tabs
 B and C, then close
 card onto glued
 ends.



- Open card. GlueTab D at bottom of presidential group onto lawn in front of Capitol.
- Push presidential group forward, face down on lawn. Pull Tabs E and F back toward card centerfold.



Glue ends of Tabs E and F.

Close card onto glued ends to finish pop-up.
